BOARD MEETING: The Board met on May 29. In addition to the items on the previous page, the Board took the following actions:

- Agreement that the kitchen & storage room should be kept unlocked. Passed a motion that a TDX trial be held during the following fiscal year as a third tracking trial.
- Agreement that the Projects Committee should give top priority to finishing the kitchen.
- Agreement that there should be landscaping timbers & mulch around the bushes. Approval of \$200 (in addition to \$100 already donated by the Grimsons) for obtaining and installing bookcases with plexiglass fronts.

Decision not to reinvest the Money Market Certificate at the current low MMC interest rates. Rather, the money will be put temporarily into the Golden Passbook account, with a final decision to be made in June. Approval that Jeanne Simmons' name be presented to the Club for Regular Membership.
