Chinese Crested: Dog of the Month



The Chinese Crested (a member of the Toy Group) is clean, without odor and does not shed. Two varieties are born in the

same litter. The Hairless with hair only on the head, tail and feet and the Powderpuff, completely covered with hair. The breed serves as a loving companion for adults and is playful, entertaining, loving and active, but not aggressive or noisy.

A unique feature of hairless dogs is that they have sweat glands. Rather than panting to release body heat as coated dogs do, they simply sweat. Properly cared for, the skin of the Hairless remains soft to the touch, yet it is thicker and tougher than that of a coated dog and it heals very quickly if scratched or cut. The Chinese Crested has a hare foot, and its elongated toes grip like human hands.

The texture of all hair is soft and silky, flowing to any length. Any color or combination of colors is acceptable. The Powderpuff variety is completely covered with a double coat. The coat is straight, of moderate density and length. Grooming is minimal-consisting of presenting a clean and neat appearance.

Background: The Chinese Crested was discovered by Chinese traders either in Mexico or Africa. He is said to have existed as far back as 1000 BC and was common in China in the mid-1800s, but has been extinct there for nearly half a century. He belongs not to the domestic dog

species of *Canis familiaris* but to *Canis africanis*.

Show Ring: The Chinese Crested is fine-boned, elegant and graceful. This breed, ideally, is 11 to 13 inches high and rectangularly proportioned.

Breeding and Whelping: There is a lethal gene involved with the Hairless; when two of these genes come together, the result is fatal. Every hairless dog carries one gene for hairless and one gene for puff and thus, both coat types are born in the same litter.

Breed Disqualifications: An excessively heavy, kinky or curly coat is penalized. Missing teeth are to be faulted in the Powderpuff, but not in the Hairless who has only primitive dentition.

Recognized Problems: Blackheads and Sunburn (Hairless) can be problems. The **teeth** in the Hairless have less enamel and occasionally may be missing. Many are **allergic** to wool and lanolin.

A Safety Reminder: Recently a situation took place, resulting in a dog lost in Raleigh, that could have been prevented had more attention been paid to the equipment that was used to restrain the dog. It's very easy for us all to become complacent

CANINE LEISHMANIASIS Cases Confirmed In 21 States

Results of DNA and blood tests obtained by scientists at North Carolina State University's College of Veterinary Medicine and the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have confirmed cases of visceral canine leishmaniasis -- a rare, often fatal tropical disease that can be transmitted to humans and other animals -- in 21 U.S. states and southern Canada.

The test results suggest leishmaniasis is substantially more widespread in North American canine populations than originally thought.

Leishmaniasis is a parasitic infection and most often occurs in rural areas of the tropics and subtropics, where the most common species of the parasite is transmitted by the bite of an infected female sand fly. Symptoms of leishmaniasis include skin lesions, nose bleeds, swollen lymph glands, weight loss, seizures, hair loss, kidney failure and swollen limbs and joints.

The disease is potentially fatal in humans, but can be treated. While there is no cure for leishmaniasis in dogs, it can be put into remission.

Breitschwerdt says leishmaniasis is prevalent in southern Europe, India and South America, but, until very recently, was not thought to be present in the United States. "I think there is the possibility that there could have been human cases in the United

States that weren't diagnosed," he says. Ongoing research efforts should allow scientists to determine the source of the U.S. canine Leishmaniasis, how it's being transmitted, and if the cases in different states come from the same strain of the organism.

Breitschwerdt and his colleagues implemented the new diagnostic tests at the College of Veterinary Medicine last spring in response to a disease outbreak among foxhounds at a New York hunt club. When foxhounds at the club began losing weight and suffering from skin lesions, seizures, swollen limbs and joints, and in most cases fatal kidney failure, the club's attending veterinarian turned to veterinary medicine researchers at NC State for help. Using the DNA and blood tests, Breitschwerdt and his team were able to confirm that the disease was canine leishmaniasis.

The NC State team has been collaborating with the CDC, the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research and the Dutchess County (New York) Department of Health to investigate the New York Leishmaniasis outbreak.

In conjunction with the CDC, they've tested foxhounds from other regions and identified canine leishmaniasis in 21 other states, including North Carolina, and southern Canada. "So we've gone from an outbreak in New York to literally a national epidemic that's probably been smoldering for 15 to 20 years," Breitschwerdt says. It's still not clear how the dogs in New York became infected.

Breitschwerdt's research and testing team is made up of more than a dozen NC State students, clinicians, pathologists and other researchers, including Dr. Michael Levy, professor of parasitology; Dr. Amanda Gaskin, internal medicine resident; Dr. Adam Birkenheuer, graduate student; and Lindsay Tomlinson, pathology instructor.
