Japanese Chin: DOG OF THE MONTH



The **Japanese Chin**, a member of the Toy Group, is a lively, aristocratic dog with a distinctive

Oriental expression. He is sensitive, intelligent, clean and an affectionate companion that can thrive in almost any climate. He is devoted to family, but can be reserved with strangers or in new situations.

Background: Although this breed is now named the **Japanese Chin**, it has also been called the Japanese Spaniel and had its origins in China. It is said that a Chinese emperor gave a pair to an emperor of Japan. The Japanese Spaniel became officially known by the AKC as the **Japanese Chin** in August of 1977.

Approved by the AKC December 8, 1992; Effective January 27, 1993.

Show Ring: Size: Ideal size is 8 inches to 11 inches at the highest point of the withers. The dog's outline presents a square appearance. **Eyes:** Set wide apart, large, round, dark in color, and lustrous. A small amount of white showing in the inner corners of the eyes is a breed characteristic that gives the dog a look of astonishment. **Ears:** Hanging, small, V-shaped, wide apart, and set slightly below the crown of the skull. **Coat:** Profuse, silky, soft and straight. **Feet:** Hare-shaped with feathering on the ends of the toes in the mature dog. **Tail:** The plumed tail is carried over the back, curving to either side. **Color:** Either black and white, red and white, or black and white with

tan points. **Bite:** The jaw is wide and slightly undershot. A dog with one or two missing or slightly misaligned teeth should not be severely penalized. The **Japanese Chin** is very sensitive to oral examination. If the dog displays any hesitancy, judges are asked to defer to the handler for presentation of the bite.

Breeding and Whelping: Litters average 3 to 5 with puppies weighing between 6 to 8 oz. at birth. Cesarean section is sometimes necessary in the smaller bitches and in those that have the preferred large head.

Disqualifications: None.

Recognized Problems: Mono-chidism or Cryptorchidism are common problems. **Achondroplasia** [Improper development of cartilage at the ends of the long bones] is an incompletely dominant autosomal trait of this breed. It causes **shortened limbs, metaphyseal flaring, depressed nasal bridge and shortened maxilla.** Elbow and **medial patellar luxations** can occur secondary to joint laxity.

Old Age: Most **Japanese Chin** live from 12 – 24 years of age.

Rally Obedience

Beginning in March, Adele Monroe will hold training for Rally-style obedience (now an AKC sport with titles in three levels). Classes will be held on Sunday mornings from 10 to 11:30 on an irregular schedule, due to building rental. Also, every effort will be made to avoid scheduling conflicts with nearby obedience and agility trials. Class dates will be posted on the DKC calendar and announced in the newsletter and to the DKC e-mail distribution list.

This class is for handlers who already know how to train dogs, but who want to learn the Rally exercises and to practice on courses. Dogs in the class should have learned how to learn and know some basic behaviors (e.g., heel, sit, down), but need not have polished behaviors to participate.

At each class, a group of Rally exercises will be introduced at the beginning of the class. Then, students will work independently at stations for those exercises that are set up around the building. It is expected that seven to eight classes will be needed to introduce all 48 exercises used in all three levels of Rally. Beginning with Class #4, one ring in the building will be set up to practice the new exercises and the other ring will be set up with a Rally course. This format may be modified based on feedback.

Because classes are held on Sundays, and the schedule is irregular, rather than registering for a series of classes, students will pay on a per-day basis (\$5 per day). Class size will be limited, so preregistration (via e-mail or phone) is required for each session.

Handlers will need to bring a current DKC health certificate (with rabies certificate), class registration form, and signed release form (similar to the form used for agility classes) **to the first class they attend.**

AKC Agility at Crufts

The AKC/USA has been invited to participate at the Crufts Dog Show held in England on March 10, 2005. Nine countries will attend this international agility competition. Each country will send one dog and handler to compete at the 26" jump

height. The judge is from Scotland and several pieces of the equipment will be very different from AKC agility.

Linda Mecklenburg and her Border Collie, Stellar have been selected to represent the American Kennel Club at Crufts. Stellar was the recently crowned 24" champion at the AKC Agility National Championship.

AKC Now Allows DNA Results Transferred From Other Registries

[Friday, February 25, 2005]

The AKC is now accepting DNA results produced by MMI Genomics through other registries, such as the Field Dog Stud Book. The move will allow coonhound and field dog customers who have already processed their DNA through MMI Genomics to transfer DNA records so the dog can become AKC DNA certified.

Previously, the AKC did not accept DNA record transfers and if dogs met the Frequently Used Sire DNA requirement the owner was required to submit a sample through the AKC DNA certification department at a cost of \$35-40. Now, AKC is offering a reduced rate of \$20 per dog to transfer the DNA data and store the information.

"Along with ease of registration, a broad network of clubs, and exciting events, this initiative will go a long way in bolstering the number of registrations as well as dogs eligible to participate in AKC Coonhound Events and Field Trials."

To transfer DNA records to AKC, dog owners must complete an AKC DNA transfer kit, which can be ordered via the AKC online store or by calling AKC DNA Operations at (919) 816-3508. Customers will need to include a copy of the MMI Genomics DNA Certificate and a new DNA sample on the Foam Tip Applicator (FTA) card along with a

properly completed DNA transfer form. This FTA sample will be archived by the AKC, and if a question arises about a dog's DNA profile, or the parentage of the dog or its offspring is in question, the FTA sample will be processed by MMI Genomics to confirm the dog's DNA profile.

CGC Test

There will be a Canine Good Citizens test given on Saturday, March 19 beginning at 8:30am.

Cost will be \$5 per dog per test. Bring those young dogs out and the old ones, too and get them certified as good citizens.

Workers are needed as well.
