WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL: DOG OF THE MONTH

The Welsh Springer Spaniel, a member of the Sporting Group, is a



dog who derives his name from his hunting style and not his relationship

to other breeds. This breed is gentle and peace loving, but very alert to strange noises. He has an excellent nose, is an outstanding water dog and never tires even under very strenuous conditions.

Background: The Welsh Springer Spaniel has been bred for centuries in isolated areas of Wales as a combination gun dog and household companion. He was shown in the first competition of the English Kennel Club in 1873. At that time, both the Welsh Springer and the English Springer were shown together since their only difference was color

Approved by the AKC: June 13, 1989; Effective August 1, 1989

Show Ring: Size: a dog is ideally 18-19 inches in height at the withers and a bitch is 17-18 inches at the withers. Deviation from the standard is *penalized*. **Eyes:** should be oval in shape, dark to medium brown in color with a soft expression. Ears: hang close to the cheeks and are comparatively small. Coat: The coat is naturally straight, flat and soft to the touch, never wiry or wavy. It is dense sufficiently tο weatherproof. Nose: black or any shade of brown. A pink nose is to be severely penalized. Feet: should be round, tight and well arched with thick pads. *Tail:* an extension of the topline. The tail is generally docked and displays a lively action. *Color:* The color is rich red and white only. **Bite:** scissors. Undershot bite is *severely penalized*.

Breeding and Whelping: There are generally no problems. Puppies average 8 to 12 ounces. Color darkens as they grow and may continue to develop until 6 months. Tails are docked 1/3 to 1/2 and dewclaws removal is not required of the standard, but is usually done.

Disqualifications: There are none.

Recognized Problems: Epileptic type seizures may be prevalent in certain breed lines. Sudden infertility in proven stud dogs at about 3.5 years which may be inherited. **Hereditary** cataract, primary glaucoma and a higherthan-average incidence of primary hypothyroidism have observed.

Old Age: The average life span of the **Welsh Springer Spaniel** is 12 to 15 years. There are no particular problems found in old age.
