Beagle: Dog of the Month Hound Group



The **Beagle**, is relatively small, but large in heart. They are judged as individuals and

as packs. The Beagle is a dog with courage and stamina in the field and is a gentle and trustworthy friend in the home.

Background: The Beagle's ancestors were probably hounds that hunted by scent in ancient Rome and early England. Modern Beagles originated in the middle of the 19th century, with the hounds of Parson Honeywell of England. They first received serious attention in the U.S. in the 1880s and 1890s.

AKC Approved: Sept. 10, 1957

Show Ring: Size: There are 2 varieties: 13"--for hounds not over 13". 15"--for hounds over 13", but not exceeding 15". Eyes: Large, brown or hazel color. Ears: Fairly broad and hanging. Bite: Scissor. Coat: Close, hard and of medium length. Feet: Close, round and firm. Pad full and hard. Tail: Short as compared with size of the hound: with brush, carried gaily. Color: Any true hound color. Packs: Judging points allotted for: General levelness of pack (40%), Individual merit of hounds (30%), Manners (20%) and Appointments (10%). Master and whips should be dressed alike. The Standard gives livery recommendations. Packs must show a unified appearance. The hounds must be as near to the same height, weight, conformation and color as possible. A good looking pack, with no individual who is of show bench quality, is to be avoided.

Breeding and Whelping: Since the 2 varieties of Beagle are interbred, the 13" bitch often has large pups and has difficulty whelping requiring a cesarean in many cases. The 15" is normally a free whelper.

Generally, the pups are black and white at birth and become tan and brown at about 3 weeks. Lemon and whites or golden and whites are all white at birth. Since there is no color standard, color is not important. Dewclaws, which may appear on 2 or all 4 paws, are removed at 3 to 5 days. Abnormalities at birth consist of missing toes, short toes, cleft lip and palate, umbilical hernias and genital irregularities.

Defects: Many are listed; all of which are basically deviations from the standard.

Disqualifications: Any hound measuring more than 15" shall be disqualified.

Recognized Problems: Primary glaucoma, several types of cataract, PRA, hemophilia A (Factor VIII deficiency), intervertebral disc disease, several kidney diseases, epilepsy and congenital deafness.

Old Age: The average life span is 12 to 15 years.
