# Bichon Frise: Dog of the Month

**Non-Sporting Group** 



The **Bichon**Frise is a small, sturdy, white dog with a happy temperament. It is affectionate,

gentle, sensitive and playful.

Background: The Bichon traces its origin to the Mediterranean area around 1300. It descended from the Barbet or Water-Spaniel from which came the name Barbichon later contracted to Bichon. In the past, Bichons were divided into 4 types: Maltais, Bolognais, Havanais and Teneriffe. The name Teneriffe was changed to Bichon Frise (plural - Bichons Frises) in France by the International Canine Federation in 1933. The breed is recognized in France, Belgium and Italy. It was introduced into the U.S. in 1958.

AKC Approved: October 11, 1988; Effective November 30, 1988.

Show Ring: Size: Dogs and bitches 9½ to 11½ " are to be given primary preference. Where the comparative superiority of a specimen outside this range clearly justifies it, greater latitude is taken. This latitude never extends over 12 inches or under 9 inches. Eves: Round, black or dark brown and are set in the skull to look directly forward. Ears: Drop and are covered with long flowing hair. Bite: Scissor. Coat: The undercoat is soft and dense; the outercoat of a coarser and curlier texture. The combination of the two gives a soft but substantial feel to the touch which is similar to plush or velvet and when patted springs back. Feet: Tight and round, resembling those of

a cat and point directly forward. **Tail:** Well plumed, set on level with the topline and curved gracefully over the back so that the hair of the tail rests on the back. **Color:** Shadings of buff, cream or apricot around the ears or on the body are acceptable.

Breeding and Whelping: Bichons are prone to silent heat. They are sensitive to pain and often need help at the delivery. The normal litter size is 4-5 pups weighing 3.5 to 4 oz. Dewclaws may be removed. They do not reach full maturity until 1 to 1.5 years.

**Serious Faults:** Eyes of any color other than black or dark brown; overshot or undershot bite, missing teeth; a corkscrew tail.

**Other Faults:** Overly large or bulging eyes and almond shaped, obliquely set eyes; absence of pigment on the eye rims.

**Disqualifications**: None.

Recognized Problems: Patellar luxation, epilepsy, heavy tartar formation and Pemphigus [a chronic ulceration disease involving the oral mucosa].

**Old Age:** The average life span is often 16 or 17 years of age.
