Dandie Dinmont TerrierTerrier Group



The Dandie Dinmont Terrier is playful, even-tempered and affectionate. They are

calmer than many other terrier breeds (but still make excellent watchdogs), good with children and content to lie quietly when their owners are busy.

Background: They were first recorded as a specific breed around 1700, originating in the hill country between England and Scotland where they hunted badgers, foxes, rats and weasels.

Approved: February 9, 1991; Effective: March 27, 1991.

Show Ring: Size: Average height is 8 to 11" and length is 1 to 2" less than twice the height. The preferred weight is from 18 to 24 lbs. Eyes: A rich dark hazel in color, large, round, bright and full, but not protruding. Eye rims dark. Ears: Floppy, broad at the base, coming almost to a point. The cartilage and skin of the ear are rather thin. The ear's length is from 3 to 4". Bite: A tight scissors bite. Coat: About 2" long. Nose: Moderately large and black or dark colored. Tail: Eight to ten inches in length. The tail is carried a little above the level of the body in a curve like a scimitar. Color: Pepper or mustard. Feet: Round and well cushioned.

Breeding and Whelping: No particular difficulties.

Faults: A stiff, stilted, hopping or weaving gait and lack of drive in the rear quarters. Bandy legs, fiddle front and flat feet are considered objectionable.

Disqualifications: None.

Recognized Problems:

Intervertebral disc syndrome, hip dysplasia, medial subluxation of the patella, luxation and subluxation of the shoulder and elbow joints. Ear infections are common. Dandies seem to have a high rate of lymphoma. Cushing's disease is seen in them, too.

Old Age: The average age of the Dandie Dinmont is 10 to 12 years, although some live to be 15.
