# Lakeland Terrier Terrier Groups



The Lakeland Terrier was bred to hunt vermin in the rugged shale mountains of the Lake District of

northern England. He is a small, workmanlike dog of square, sturdy build. His body is deep and relatively narrow, which allows him to squeeze into rocky dens. His attitude is gay, friendly, and self-confident, but not overly aggressive. He is alert and ready to go.

Background: The Lakeland Terrier was first known as the Patterdale Terrier originating in the Patterdale Lake District. It was bred to hunt fox and otter. In 1871, a Lakeland Terrier is said to have crawled 25 feet under rock in pursuit of game. Freeing the entombed dog took 3 days of blasting.

Approved: January 15, 1991 Effective: February 27, 1991

Show Ring: Height: The ideal height of the mature dog is 141/2 inches from the withers to the ground, with up to a one-half inch deviation either way permissible. Bitches may measure as much as one inch less than dogs.. Weight: The weight of the well balanced, mature male in hard show condition approximately 17 lbs. averages Moderately small Eves: and somewhat oval in outline. Ears: Small, V-shaped. Bite: Teeth, which are comparatively large, may meet in either a level, edge to edge bite, or a slightly overlapping scissors bite. Coat: Two-ply or double, the outer coat is hard and wiry in texture. The undercoat is close to the skin and soft and should never overpower the wiry outer coat. The Lakeland is

hand stripped to show his outline.. *Color:* A variety of colors, all of which are equally acceptable. Solid colors include blue, black, liver, red, and wheaten. In saddle marked dogs, the saddle covers the back of the neck, back, sides and up the tail. Grizzle is a blend of red or wheaten intermixed in varying proportions with black, blue or liver. **Feet:** The feet turn neither in nor out.

Breeding and Whelping: An interval between seasons of 12 to 15 months is not rare. First estrus can be as late as 2 years. The average litter is 3 to 4 pups and whelping is generally easy if the bitch is not overweight. Most pups are almost solid black at birth with possible tan points. Dewclaws are removed and tails docked.

**Disqualifications:** Overshot on undershot bites.

Recognized Problems: Cryptorchidism, possible incidence of Legg-Perthes and Von Willebrand's disease.

**Old Age:** Lakeland Terriers remain vigorous into old age, living for 15 years or longer.

# AKC Introduces Online Record Keeping (continued From Page 3)

With the new Online Record Keeping service, breeders can record mating and birth information for litters and view official AKC litter registration information including dog registration status for all puppies in a litter.

There is also a handy address book function that gives breeders an easy place to store contact information for co-owners and puppy buyers. And the AKC's secure, password protected breeder record service keeps your information secure and private. In addition to being able to record and view information, breeders can also quickly print AKC Dog Ownership, Breeding, and Litter records. If the breeder completes the necessary fields in the record-keeping system, all of the information required for AKC record-keeping rules and regulations will be pre-populated on these

This new service also allows a breeder to record sale and ownership information for the puppies and to manage puppy records by adding notes about breeding and whelping. For those breeders that have already taken advantage of online dog registration to record sale and new ownership information for their puppies, this information has been moved to the Online Record Keeping section of My AKC for easier access. If you have an authenticated My AKC account (or want to start one - just go to the home page on the upper right hand box and start the quick process), maintaining your dog and litter records online is just a click away

Follow these easy steps to get started:

- 1. Login to your My AKC account.
- 2. Sign up for **Online Record Keeping** services from the main page.
- Go to the My Dogs and Litters section.
- 4. Click Breeder Records to view, create and maintain breeder records, view AKC litter and puppy registration information, and manage puppy records.
