# **Briard**Herding Group



The Briard has the distinction of having eyebrows and beard, which give the typical expression of the breed and the tail has a

small hook at the end, called a crochet.

Briards learn readily and training should begin at a young age. Although Briards have been used primarily as guarding and herding dogs, they are usually versatile. They also have served successfully as tracking and hunting dogs and they have a splendid record as war dogs. Even though it has all these wonderful qualities, the Briard is not the ideal dog for every home. The remarkable character of the breed can only be developed by a willingness on the part of the owner to devote time and affection.

**Background:** The Briard, a very old breed of French working dog, is shown in French tapestries as early as the 8th century, but its record is not well documented. History credits both the Marquis de Lafayette and Thomas Jefferson with bringing specimens of the Briard to the Americas.

Approved: February 8, 1975 Reformatted: January 12, 1992

Show Ring: Height: Dogs, 23 to 27"; bitches, 22 to 251/2". Eyes: Set well apart, large, black or black-brown. Ears: High, should have thick leather and be firm at the base. The ear can be natural or cropped. Teeth: A scissors bite. Coat: The outer coat is coarse, hard and dry (making a dry rasping sound between the fingers). It lies down flat, falling naturally in long, slightly waving locks. The undercoat is fine and tight on all the body. Color: All uniform colors are permitted except white. The colors are black, various shades of gray and various shades of tawny. The deeper shades of each color are preferred. Feet: Strong rounded and slightly oval.

**Dewclaws:** Two dewclaws are required on each rear leg. **Tail:** Uncut, well feathered, forming a crook at the extremity.

Breeding and Whelping: The most common reason for puppy deaths in the first 2 weeks is being smothered by the bitch. Litters are large and it is recommended that pups be fed in shifts. This is generally not a problem because the bitch is usually a good milk producer. Tails are not docked and dewclaws are not removed from the rear legs. **Puppies** require extensive socialization beginning when they are 3 weeks old through the 1st year. Briards do not attain full maturity until the age of 3 years.

**Disqualifications:** All dogs or bitches under the minimum size limits, yellow eyes or spotted eyes, nose any color other than black., tail non-existent or cut, less than two dewclaws on each rear leg, white coat, spotted coat, white spot on chest exceeding one inch in diameter.

Recognized Problems: Hip dysplasia, gastric torsion, hypothyroidism and PRA in British bred dogs.

**Old Age:** Life expectancy is 10, but some live to be 12 to 13.

# **Debbie Sugg**

Deborah Anne Sugg died Dec. 21 of complications from Wegener's granulomatosis, a rare inflammation of the blood vessels. She was 56.

Debbie was an active member of the DKC for many years and will be missed by many who remember her as a person of rare spirit and exceptional talents. Debbie could not see, but this did not stop her from competing in obedience and winning.

From about first grade on, Debbie lived away from home. She attended the Governor Morehead School, the state's school for the blind in Raleigh.

After graduating as salutatorian in 1969, she enrolled at N.C. State University.

In college, she'd play cassettes of lectures and reading assignments, then take notes in Braille after class. She earned A's, although her strategy didn't work as well in P.E., where she got B's. She could have been exempt, but she spurned special treatment.

After N.C. State, Debbie earned a master's from Duke University and a doctorate from UNC-Chapel Hill, both in special education. She wanted to help children like her.

She did that two ways, working with visually impaired children and with the teachers who taught them. She helped blind children as a consultant in the Durham Public Schools, and, as a professor at N.C. Central University, she taught teachers how to work most effectively with blind children in their classes.

About 10 years ago, she began training and showing shelties and continued until she grew too weak.

#### Her last guide dog

Her love for animals expanded to include the four guide dogs she relied upon to help her navigate the world alone. She was a junior in college when she got her first. Her last, Xylan, 9, is living now with Debbie's parents.

He accompanied Debbie everywhere, including her classroom at NCCU. In her office, he stayed under her desk.

He is dealing with Debbie's death in his own way. Trained to never leave her, Xylan has refused to enter her room since she died.

Deborah Sugg is survived by her parents, a sister and a brother.

# Entries For 2009 Show Open

## To All Competitors

NEW YORK, NY (February 29, 2008) - The American Kennel Club® is pleased to announce that the 2009 AKC/ Eukanuba National Championship will be the platform for AKC's 125th anniversary celebration. In recognition of this milestone, the AKC will waive the invitational format. As was the case for AKC's centennial show in 1984, classes will be offered at the breed level and championship points will be awarded.

The event will take place in Long Beach, CA on Saturday, December 12 and Sunday, December 13, 2009 and will continue to showcase the top American dogs as well as offer the popular Bred-by-Exhibitor competition and Eukanuba World Challenge. AKC anticipates a very significant entry and therefore an entry limit may be necessary. the panel for this show will consist of almost 90 judges.

To further commemorate the anniversary, AKC Parent Clubs are invited to hold a specialty or supported entry in conjunction with this show. If a Parent Club chooses not to participate, then local specialty clubs will be given the opportunity to join us. Eukanuba National The AKC/ Championship will return to an invitation-only format in 2010. All dogs who would have qualified for the 2009 show will be invited to attend the 2010 show, along with the 2010 qualifiers.

The AKC National Obedience Invitational and AKC Agility Invitational will be held in conjunction with the 2009 AKC/ Eukanuba National Championship. The Los Encinos Kennel Club, Kennel Club of Beverly Hills and Long Beach Kennel Club shows will precede the AKC/ Eukanuba National Championship at the same site on Dec. 9-11, 2009.

## **Bacteria in Snow**

If your dogs become ill after eating snow, this could be the cause.

Scientists have known for about forty years that bacteria cling to ice high in the atmosphere in order to produce rain and snow.

However, U.S. scientists only recently found out that biological organisms, such as bacteria and other such microorganisms, play a significant role in the formation and distribution of precipitation.

"Bacteria are by far the most active ice nuclei in nature," said Brent C. Christner, an assistant professor of biological sciences at Louisiana State University.

The most common bacteria found was Psedomonas syringae, which can cause disease in several types of plants including tomatoes, green beams and other similar plants.

The bacterium was found in 20 samples of snow from around the world and the study showed that the most bacteria-rich snow came from France, followed by Montana and the Yukon. It was even found in snow from Antarctica while subsequent research has also found it in summer rainfall in Louisiana.
