AKC Announces New Legislation Tracking

[May 7, 2009] The AKC Government Relations Legislation Tracking Service enables you to check the status of all 2009 canine legislation in each of the 50 states, as well as federal legislation.

To use this service, go to the AKC Government Relations web page, www.akc.org/canine legislation

and click on the large "AKC Government Relations 2009 Legislation Tracking" icon. This will bring you to a new page with a clickable map of the United States. To view federal legislation, click on the "US Fed" icon to the right of the map. You can also click on any state to view that state's pending canine legislation, the latest legislative developments, the progress of specific bills, and, if applicable, AKC legislative alerts and messages. In addition, you can view the actual text of the bill or read a brief official legislative summary.

The AKC does not have a position on every bill posted; rather, this service is meant as a reference tool for you to see all the issues being considered in your state.

AKC Highlights From The May 11 & 12, 2009 Meeting

Some highlights from the May 2009 meeting of the AKC Board of Directors are as follows:

The Russell Terrier will become eligible to compete in the Miscellaneous Class, effective Jan. 1, 2010.

The kennel name "Sunnybank (Al-

bert Payson Terhune) was retired for Collies, and the kennel name "Squier" (Richard H. and Doris Squier) was retired for Field Spaniels.

The Board approved the new suffix title, Certificate of Merit (CM) for dogs competing in the Miscellaneous Class, effective January 1, 2010. The details are in the May 2009 AKC Board minutes.

The Guidelines for Conformation Dog Show Judges were amended to prohibit a judge from using the services of an agent for at least four months after that agent exhibited under the judge. Previously, the Guidelines only specified four months before.

The Rally Regulations were amended, effective immediately, to allow clubs to put the date of the trial and the name of the club on the face, back tab, or on a label attached to the ribbon.

The AKC Regulations for Agility Trials were amended, effective September 1, 2009, to allow clubs to hold a FAST class agility trial on the day preceding or following two consecutive days of agility trials

DKC Membership Meeting 5/18/09

<u>Program</u>: Leigh Poole gave a program about Pack Dog Hiking. She has a Greater Swiss Mountain Dog and they compete in this sport. Leigh talked about the sport and promoted it as a sport for all dogs.

<u>President's Report</u>: Minutes from the April membership meeting were approved.

<u>Committee Reports</u>: Lisa Roberts reported that **agility classes** are discontinued for the summer, but open work will be available. [See Lisa's e-mail to members.]

George Beglane reported that the last **CGC** went well.

Jan Gray reported that **December Obedience and Rally Trials** are on.

Peggy Schmidt reported there was a cluster meeting for the **fall and spring shows**. It was decided that the entry fees will be raised to \$28 and no reduced fees for puppy classes, but juniors are \$12. This was against the wishes of the Durham and Salisbury Kennel Clubs. Soy for Canine Cancers

ScienceDaily (Apr. 11, 2009) — Researchers at NC State University are looking to soy as a way to make traditional canine cancer therapy more effective, less stressful for the dog and less costly for the owners.

Dr. Steven Suter, assistant professor of oncology, and NC State colleagues studied genistein - a molecule found in soy that has been shown to be toxic to a wide variety of cancer cells in humans - to determine whether it would also inhibit

the growth of canine lymphoma cells.

The researchers found that a commercially available form of genistein called GCP was effective in killing canine lymphoid cells in a laboratory setting, and that GCP is "bioavailable" in canines - meaning it is absorbed into the bloodstream where it can affect cancer cells in the body. The researchers' findings were published in *Clinical Cancer Research*.
