Westminster 2011: Six New Dog Breeds!

### **BOYKIN SPANIEL** (Sporting Group)



The Boykin Spaniel is a versatile and compact gundog. The breed was developed in the early 1900's in the Midlands of South Carolina to fill the need of local hunters for a smaller retriever for hunting waterfowl. Their nickname is apropos: "the little dog that doesn't rock the boat." In the field, they steal the show as tenacious, assertive and enthusiastic flushing and retrieving Spaniels. In the home, they steal hearts as gentle, affectionate and fiercely loyal members of the family. They are truly companions for all seasons. In 1985, Governor Richard Riley signed an act making the Boykin Spaniel South Carolina's official state dog. www.boykinspanielclub.org

### **BLUETICK COONHOUND** (Hound Group)

The Bluetick Coonhound is an athletic, compact, speedy and well-muscled hound, all of which helps it in trailing and treeing raccoons and other small game. A determined and steady tracker, the standard says that the Bluetick "should be a free tonguer on trail with a medium bawl or bugle voice." Its name comes from its dark blue coat pattern, covered in ticking and featuring black spots on its ears, back and sides. That color may

come from the Grand Bleu de Gascogne (French Staghound) as well as the English Foxhound. In America, Blueticks were referred to as English Coonhounds for many years. www.akc.org/breeds/bluetick\_coonhound/



### **CANE CORSO** (Working Group)

The Cane Corso is an ancient Italian Breed, robust and muscular, medium-to-large in size, yet still elegant and athletic. Historically found on the family farms, its primary function was minder of livestock and property, as well as hunting companion for large game. The overall demeanor of the Cane Corso is confidence and impressive presence.

The Cane Corso is highly intelligent and easily trained, being docile and affectionate with family and friends. The breed faced extinction in Italy in the early 1970s, but working dogs from rural farms helped it to recover. The Cane Corso was initially

The Icelandic Sheepdog arrived in Iceland on the longboats of the first Viking settlers. Its working method adapted to the struggle for survival, making it indispensable. A hardy and agile Nordic herding Spitz that barks, it is slightly under



medium sized with prick ears and a curled tail. It is rectangular when seen from the side. The coat is thick and extremely weatherproof. A confident and lively bearing is typical for this dog. The expression is gentle, intelligent and happy. Being very alert, it will give visitors an enthusiastic welcome without aggression. ### **LEONBERGER** (Working Group)




The Leonberger is a large, muscular, and elegant dog distinguished by a black mask and medium-length weather resistant coat of lion-yellow to reddish-brown color. Males and females are easily distinguished by size, with males carrying a lion-

like mane. The Leonberger combines confident calmness with intelligence and a lively temperament. For its size the Leonberger is graceful and light on its feet. Originating in Baden-Wýrttemberg, Germany, in the mid-nineteenth century the Leonberger was kept as a farm dog and valued for its watch and draft abilities. Today the Leonberger is an excellent family companion, comfortable performing a wide variety of jobs. www.leonbergerclubofamerica.com

### **REDBONE COONHOUND** (Hound Group)

With a pleading expression accompanied by a confident air. the Redbone Coonhound is a courageous breed. Known for being a versatile hunter of tremendous skill, they are used on differing game from raccoon, bear to mountain



lion. Dating back before the Civil War, breeders and hunters strove to have a hound that could not only perform in the woods but have a strikingly beautiful look. ### **DKC Meeting Minutes: January 17, 2011**

Program: "Tellington TTouch" delivered by Patricia Tirrell.

Meeting called to order by President George Beglane.

The minutes from the November meeting were approved as published in the newsletter.

President's Report: There was extensive discussion regarding DKC land development and building expansion plans, as well as proposals to hold additional Obedience/Rally Trials at NetSports and possibly holding stand-alone trials as an alternative to offering obedience and rally at future Spring and Fall Shows. George announced the availability of the new discussion forums on the DKC web site, and encouraged members to use the forums to express their opinions on planning for the future. Member input is critical to future planning.

Corresponding Secretary: No report.

Treasurer's Report: Roger Akers reported the figures provided in each DKC fund. There was discussion about maintaining a capital improvement account, either as a separate account or as a separate category within our existing accounts.

AKC Delegate: Linda Wozniak reported on Breeder of Merit, Grand Champion and proposals for adding a 4-6 month puppy class and a Reserve Best in Show award. She also reported statistics on titles earned by All-American dogs since they are now allowed to compete in AKC events.

Spring Show: The premium lists will be coming out soon. Connie Howard stated she still needs volunteers for the Grounds Chair and the Compliance Chair for the show. Committee chairs will soon be looking for volunteers as well. Lois Schultz is still taking memorial ads for the catalog – the deadline is tonight.

Fall Show: No report.

Agility trial: Plans for the upcoming trials are progressing.

Obedience and Rally Trials: The December trials at NetSports were a success. Our net profit was less than the profit for the smaller trials held at DKC in previous years, but the entry was much larger and we were able to have vendors and to hold a raffle to supplement our income.

Tracking: Jack Sappenfield reported that our next TDX test will be held February 13th at Quail Roost Farm. After that test, he will step down as Tracking Chair. Liz Rende will assume the role, and Jack and Liz have worked together closely to ensure a smooth transition.

Agility classes: There will be a short sequence class starting January 24th.

Obedience classes: New classes begin January 18th. Many of the classes are filled.

Conformation classes: Connie Howard reported that classes

are held most Thursdays from 7:00 to 8:30. There are now 4 instructors.

Seminars: No report.

Membership Report: Terri Toohil read four applications for Candidate Membership: Donna Reilly, Bill and Kay Cundy, and Kate Elliott. Don Roback was voted in as a Regular Member. Cathy Whitaker will be voted on for Regular Membership at the next member meeting.

Here's another great recipe from the crockpot lunches we had at the Obedience & Rally show this past December. Besides being delicious, this one has the added benefit of being gluten-free!

There are still a few more recipes to come!

### Sue's Gluten-free Southwest Stew

(Sue Ivy)

- 2 lbs lean stew beef, cubed
- 1/2 cup rice flour
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1 ½ TBSP chili powder
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- 1/4 tsp pepper 1 large onion, chopped

- 2 cloves minced garlic
- 2 16 oz cans whole-kernel corn
- 2 16 oz cans Ranch Beans
- 2 16 oz cans cubed potatoes
- 1 jar Newman's Own Black bean & Corn salsa
- 32 oz beef stock (in a box)
- ¼ cup olive or canola oil

Combine flour, salt, pepper, cumin and chili in a 1 gallon Ziploc plastic bag or similar. Toss beef cubes until coated.

Add olive oil to kettle or Dutch oven. When oil starts to ripple, add beef cubes and brown. Add onion and garlic and saute, stirring, until soft. Add beef stock and simmer for 1 hour. Drain liquid from corn, beans and potatoes and add to beef. Stir in salsa and continue simmering for another hour.

Top with grated cheddar cheese, if desired.
