Welcome to the last formal DKC Newsletter!

I think most of you would agree that the Newsletter, in its present form, is outdated. Almost all of the announcements have already been sent out at least once through email. Other information pertaining to seminars, clinics, etc., is on the website.

The By-Laws state that the monthly meetings be announced in the *Newsletter*; however an email announcement is acceptable, and that's how you will get that information from now on. The Minutes from the Members Meetings will also be available on-line, so you can read and "approve" them there.

So. We are making the website the primary source of information. George Beglane has created a new site that allows interaction from the members. George and I have been busy creating new pages and transferring information over from the current site.

In this new format, I have taken each activity that the Club supports, given it its own page, and provided basic information. Two new areas that we want to develop are (1) Lost Dog(s) and (2) New Members. I know first-hand how helpless you feel when your dogs go missing, so with your help, I want to put together the valuable information you need to get your dog home as quickly as possible. For new members, how can we attract new people and make them feel welcome? Why should they join the DKC?

We will demo this new interface at the Members Meeting, on Monday, August 19, 2013 (yes, there is a meeting in August!), so I hope you can come and join the discussion. If not, we will soon send out the address for the new site and we are very anxious to hear your suggestions and comments. What new pages would be helpful? How can we organize-- or reorganize-- the information so it's more accessible?

We want to make the DKC website a vital part of the membership, so please let us hear from you!

I have enjoyed doing the *Newsletter* for the past few years, but I'm very excited to work with the new format. I hope it's fun for everyone.

Recipe Corner

Nutritional Info: Serving size: 1 each, 45 calories (15 from fat), 1.5g total fat, 0g saturated fat, 10mg cholesterol, 10mg sodium, 6g carbohydrate (1g dietary fiber, 1g sugar), 2g protein

HOMEMADE PEANUT BUTTER AND BANANA DOG TREATS

1 banana, peeled 1/2 cup dried parsley
1 cup oat flour 3 tablespoons peanut butter

• 2/3 cup rolled oats 1 egg, beaten

Preheat oven to 300°F. Put banana in a large bowl and use a spoon or potato masher to mash it thoroughly. Add oat flour, oats, parsley, peanut butter and egg and stir well to combine. Set aside for 5 minutes.

Roll mixture into 24 balls, using about 1 tablespoon dough for each; transfer to a large parchment paper-lined baking sheet as done. Use the back of a spoon or the heel of your hand to press each ball into a (1 1/2- to 2-inch) coin. Bake until firm and deep golden brown on the bottom, 40 to 45 minutes. Set aside to let cool completely.

Storage note: It's best to store these in an airtight container in the refrigerator. Or, freeze them for later; just be sure to thaw the treats befor handing them out.
