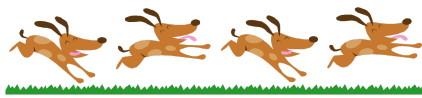

Our annual Yard Sale is scheduled for Saturday, July 20, 8 AM-12 Noon

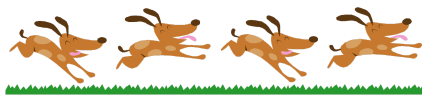

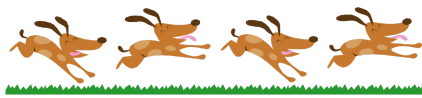

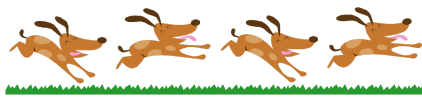
From Vicky Gillow - Sunday Show-N-Go

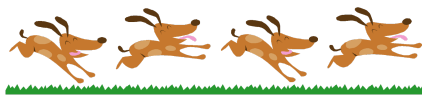
