In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. 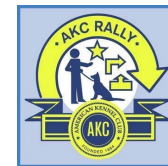

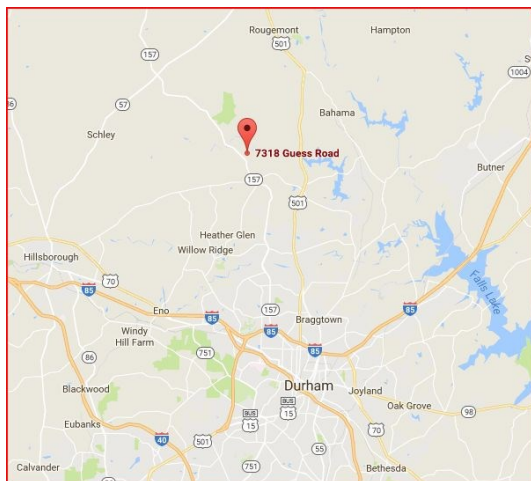

DIRECTIONS TO THE DURHAM KENNEL CLUB

From I-85 North or South, take Guess Road (NC 157) exit off I-85, go approximately 8.5 miles north (away from Durham). The Durham Kennel Club drive is on the right side of the road and is marked by a blue sign. The gravel drive ends at the Durham Kennel Club.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Due to limited space, no unentered dogs will be allowed in the building.

THERE WILL BE NO FOOD AVAILABLE AT THESE TRIALS.

Limited crating space will be available for entered dogs.

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and themselves in and around the building and parking area.

Dogs cannot be left in the building overnight.

Entry Fees: \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog and \$22.00 each additional entry of the same dog in the same trial. An AKC recording fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered in each of the Rally trials.

A wait list will be maintained in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 27 in order to fill openings created by withdrawals before closing.

Closing date for entries: 11:00 pm, Wednesday, September 23 2020 at the Trial Secretary's office after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted. Telegraph, emailed, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. If you would like your confirmation letter and judging program sent via US Postal Service, you may either not provide your email address on your entry or you may specifically request USPS.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Bitches in season: Bitches that come in season after the closing date of the obedience trial may have all but \$10.00 of the entry fee refunded upon receipt by the trial secretary of a veterinarian certificate prior to the beginning hour of judging.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 16. Transfers must be submitted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial for which the transfer is being requested.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. Owners and Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS COVID-19 ACCOMODATIONS

DURHAM KENNEL CLUB WILL CONFORM TO ALL NC STATE GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS THAT EXIST AT THE TIME OF THE TRIAL. ANY CHANGES TO INFORMATION BELOW WILL BE SENT WITH FINAL CONFIRMATION. COVID-19 WAIVER SENT WITH FINAL CONFIRMATION WILL NEED TO BE SIGNED AND PROVIDED UPON CHECK-IN AT THE EVENT.

IF THE TRIAL IS CANCELLED DUE TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS, FULL REFUND OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE MADE less any PayPal fees charged.

- A. Crating may be allowed in the building, but handlers will be required to wait in their vehicles during classes larger than ten exhibitors. Crating area will be marked off with boxes at least six feet apart.
- B. Check in will be on the porch or just inside the front door, where there will be an envelope for each exhibitor containing their armband(s), rubber band, catalog (if pre-ordered), and course map. Exhibitors will not have to check in again at ringside.
- C. Sign will be posted outside the front door with the next five exhibitors so they may exercise and warm up their dogs before their run. If possible, an additional steward will text/call these exhibitors if cell numbers are provided. Exhibitors will enter through the front door and exit through the door at the end of the building.
- D. Tear Sheets will not be posted, they will be scanned and sent to exhibitors with confirmation of scores.
- E. Masks will be required in the building at all times (in and out of the ring).
- F. No spectators inside the building.
- G. COVID Waiver will need to be signed and returned for all exhibitors, judges, and volunteers.
