In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

An hour of judging will be held until June 1 2023 for entries via USPS. After June 1 2023, the trial will be filled with entries in the order in which they were received.

Closing Date for entries is 5 pm June 28 2023 at the Trial Secretary's office or when the numerical limits have been reached after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted. Telegraph, emailed, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Any entry sent via express mail or any other similar service must be sent "no signature required".

All checks and money orders should be payable to: **Durham Kennel Club** or **DKC**. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. A fee of \$20 will be charged for any returned check. No entry will be accepted without payment and signature.

Durham Kennel Club, Inc. accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry from instructions and Rules Applying to Dog Shows (Rules) of the American Kennel Club. From time to time, these are subject to change. In the event of a discrepancy in these entry form instructions, Agreement and rules versus the text within the entry from you sign and submit, the AKC Agreement entry form instructions and rules in effect at the time these entries close will take precedence.

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the same for each event. You must use a separate entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class in different events.

The Club cautions all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards with may exist, including but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors, and stairways, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords, and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

No food is available at the trial

Due to limited space, no un-entered dogs will be allowed in the building. Limited crating space will be available for entered dogs. Dogs cannot be left in building overnight

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and themselves in and around the building and parking area..

A wait list will be maintained in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 27 in order to fill openings created by withdrawals up to five days before the trial.

An hour of judging will be held until June 1 2023 for entries via USPS. After June 1 2023, the trial will be filled with entries in the order in which they were received.

UDX/PUDX will be offered as a class. Dogs entered in the UDX or PUDX Class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B or Preferred Open and Utility and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or Utility B Class or Preferred Open or Utility, the UDX or PUDX Class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. If you would like your confirmation letter and judging program sent via US Postal Service, you may either not provide your email address on your entry or you may specifically request snail mail.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Bitches in season: Bitches that come in season after the closing date of the obedience trial may have the entry fee refunded upon receipt by the trial secretary of a veterinarian certificate prior to the beginning hour of judging.

It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 16. Transfers must be submitted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial for which the transfer is being requested.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. Owners and Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged

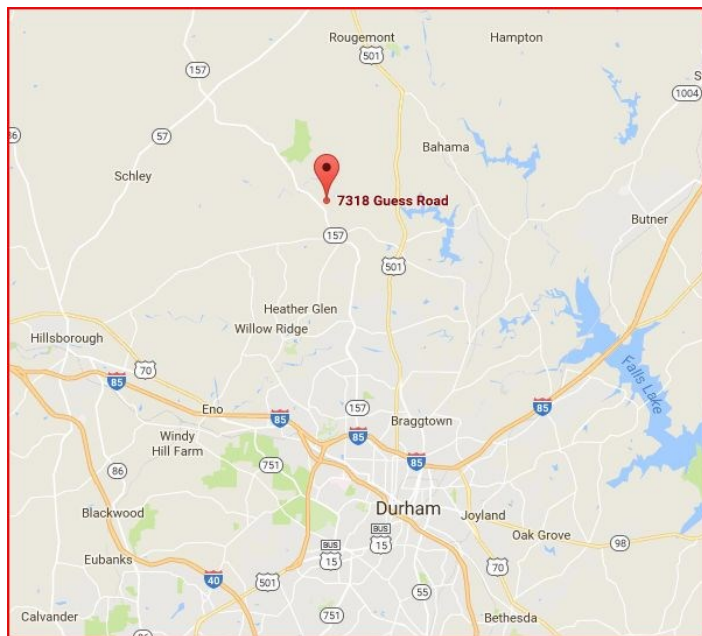
